

SuccessEd ELLA Program Compliance: Statuses “Cheat Sheet”

- Active and Denial statuses--allow you to create/edit forms for a student.

Active:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ MANUAL ENTRY ➤ All students who need to have forms added, edited or locked in the system who are not parent denials. ➤ This includes students being evaluated, those served through Bilingual or ESL programs, and those students who are currently being Monitored.
Denial:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ MANUAL ENTRY ➤ Parent denies permission for the student to participate in the Bilingual/ESL program. ➤ Forms can still be edited/created for this student.
DNQ:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ MANUAL ENTRY ➤ Student has a primary language other than English but is found to be ineligible for services.
Return to General Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ MANUAL ENTRY ➤ Student has completed the monitor process and will no longer be considered to be EL in the application. ➤ This student will roll into the Inactive campus over the summer unless he/she has an active status in another SuccessEd program.
Withdrawn	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ MANUAL ENTRY ➤ Student who is no longer enrolled in the district.
Not Active:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ MANUAL ENTRY ➤ Student is not in a Bilingual/ESL program and does not fit in any of the other categories.
